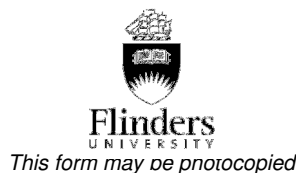

The SA Writers' Centre, City of Onkaparinga, Seaview Press and SALMAT have been fostering South Australian writers for many years. They are now delighted to embark on the *Poetry Unhinged Single Collection of Poetry Competition*, a joint initiative designed to offer emerging writers a chance to produce a high-quality collection of work.

One prize only

Projected Publication Date

The book will be ready for publication six weeks after the announcement of the winner.

Conditions of Entry

1. Entrants must be current residents of South Australia.
2. Entrants must not have previously published a book of their own poetry.
3. Only one entry per person is allowed and must consist of poetry in the English language.
4. Entries must be 70 pages of poetry in length.
5. Poems must be typed or printed on one side only of A4 pages and be securely fastened with a rubber band. Pages must be numbered. No cover sheet is necessary. The author's name should appear only on the entry form, not the poems. A pseudonym is not required.
6. Each entry must be accompanied by an entry fee of \$10 (includes GST) and a fully completed entry form.
7. Entries received or post-marked up to and including the closing date will be considered.
8. Entries will not be accepted by fax, email or computer disk.
9. All entries will be destroyed after the completion of the competition, ie: they will not be returned.
10. The judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. The organising committee of the Poetry Unhinged Festival reserves the right not to award a prize if no entries are considered to be of a publishable standard.
12. The winner must meet delivery deadlines as prescribed by Seaview Press and the completed manuscript (not the entry) must meet Seaview Press standard guidelines for manuscript presentation.
13. Conditions of winning entry: typesetting from disk or email, black text on white bond 80gsm paper. Colour covers will be full-colour 250gsm gloss laminated; plain covers will be gloss laminated on a white or coloured 200gsm board. All covers will include an ISBN and bar code, back cover blurb, and one or two illustrations supplied by the author. Books will be perfect bound. Deposits will be made at the National Library of Australia, State Library of South Australia and South Australian Parliamentary Library (as required by law). The book will be in Seaview Press's annual catalogue and on its web site as available for sale (up to 22% commission to Seaview Press). Orders can be directed to the author and/or to Seaview Press, which can accept credit cards. Not included: freight (\$33 to Australian capital cities, \$66 elsewhere); other illustrations (black and white: \$9.90 as scans; \$33 as artwork; colour \$9.90 as scans; \$33 as artwork, plus an additional 66 cents per leaf per book) any scanning or typing of text (\$7.70 a page), editing (\$880 with this offer only), marketing, distribution or promotion of books.
