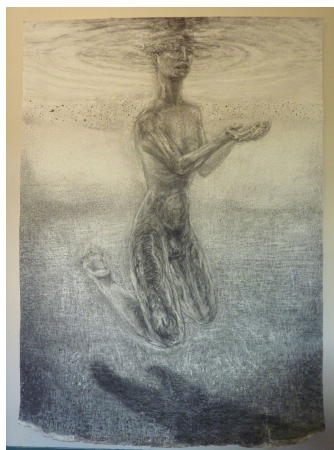
# Exhibitions

**ADELAIDE  
FRINGE 2011**  
18 FEBRUARY - 13 MARCH

Our upcoming Fringe exhibition **Migration & Transformation** is the work of Lauryn Arnott. The exhibition will be launched on Sunday 20 February at 2pm by Associate Professor Christopher Orchard, Head of Drawing at Adelaide Central School of Art.

The exhibition runs from 17 February – 13 March 2011.

Lauryn Arnott was born in Zambia, Central Africa, and lived during the emerging democracies of South Africa and Zimbabwe. This history has left a consciousness of injustice and an imminent peril that can be evidenced in some of her work, and indeed in her person, a sense of constant alertness and urgency.

She has exhibited her work in many international exhibitions and has her work in museum collections in South Africa, Zimbabwe and Botswana.

This will be an absorbing and challenging exhibition and a rare opportunity to see the development of an artist's work over a period of time.

In addition to the exhibition we are planning an exciting series of workshops conducted by Lauryn Arnott herself.
