



# SAUERBIER HOUSE culture exchange

## [GRAFTd] EXHIBITION

### Exhibit at Sauerbier House in 2023-24

Sauerbier House is currently accepting applications from local or visiting contemporary artists and curators to exhibit or curate a [GRAFTd] exhibition into the galleries of Sauerbier House, Port Noarlunga. Sauerbier House programs are aimed at supporting and fostering contemporary art practice within the City of Onkaparinga. [GRAFTd] exhibitions offer the supported opportunity for contemporary curators and artists to present new works previously unseen in South Australia. Exhibitions will be programmed between May 2023 and May 2024.

Applications close **midnight Monday 26 September 2022**

Programs hosted by Sauerbier House are dedicated to platform accessible, inclusive and cultural dialogues to support and encourage local creative exchange through contemporary arts.

Gallery spaces are available between 4-6 weeks running concurrent with the Sauerbier House Artist in Residence program.

Artists/curators can apply to hold;

- a solo or larger group exhibition across all galleries
- a smaller exhibition in a single space

Artists/curators applying to occupy a single gallery space will be curated by Sauerbier House staff to exhibit alongside another successful applicant who has also applied for a single gallery space. Up to four exhibitions can be held across the space at one time. We recommend visiting the galleries to check for suitability prior to applying.

\*Due to the heritage listing of Sauerbier House some installation restrictions may apply. Should the successful artist anticipate intervening with existing heritage structures, walls and garden areas, development applications must be made well in advance to installation. This possibility should be noted in your application and feasibility discussed prior to submission.

### **Community engagement**

Community engagement is an important element of the [GRAFTd] exhibition program. We believe offering creative opportunities to engage with exhibiting artists/curators supports our wider community to authentically experience contemporary arts practice. It is anticipated, alongside presenting a [GRAFTd] exhibition, artists/curators will facilitate at least one considered and planned opportunity for the wider community to engage with the exhibition, curator or contributing artists. This event should be delivered in a manner that is authentic to the facilitators practice and can be offered as artist talk, skill sharing workshops, demonstrations either on or offline. This event will be held at Sauerbier House during the exhibition period and arranged in conjunction with the program coordinator.

### **Support**

- Galleries are provided free of charge to the successful artist/curator.
- Sauerbier House will provide in-kind support to sign, staff, promote and launch the [GRAFTd] exhibition and will oversee the running of galleries during exhibition. Artist/curator input in the planning of exhibition launch is encouraged.
- Artists may be financially supported to host specific community engagements; details are to be negotiated with the Sauerbier House coordinator and support is dependent on event. Sauerbier House is unable to offer financial assistance with any costs associated with mounting of exhibitions and /or extra publicity costs other than those outlined above
- Sauerbier House staff can provide professional support and advice to emerging creatives.
- Sponsorship arrangements will be the responsibility of the artist.

### **Exhibition requirements**

- Artwork must be original artworks previously unseen in South Australia.
- All work will be ready to exhibit at time of install.
- Artist /curators will be responsible for installation and dismantling of the exhibition
- It is requested that artist/curator is available for gallery sitting, two Saturday afternoon sessions during the exhibition dates.
- Sauerbier House is open to public Wed – Friday 10am-4pm and Saturday noon-4pm. Events and community engagement will be presented during these open hours.
- All artworks are insured whilst on display at Sauerbier House. (conditions apply)
- All electrical equipment used at Sauerbier House must be tested and tagged in compliance with Australian standards prior to usage in the house
- Sauerbier House reserves the right to document any work and maintain a digital database of works for publicity purposes with acknowledgement of the original artist/s.
- [GRAFTd] exhibitions can coincide with state-wide festivals and events. Priority programming may be given to applications that can display a clear affiliation with these events. Please specify these connections in your application form.
- Festival registration fees may be covered by Sauerbier House.
- As Sauerbier House has limited available technical equipment, artists/curators may be responsible for provision of own equipment

### **Sales**

- Any sales of work will attract 25% commission payable to the City of Onkaparinga.
- It is the artist's / exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of issues and the ramifications of being a 'hobbyist', possessing or not possessing an ABN or issues with the claiming or charging of GST on their work.
- Copyright of all work remains with the artist.

### **Promotion**

- Sauerbier House will promote exhibition via selected print and e/publicity.
- All other bills, advertising accounts, promotion and opening costs incurred for the exhibition will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor/s and is not to be billed to Sauerbier House or the City of Onkaparinga, either by name or address.

## Artist

- Successful artist/s will hold adequate public and personal liability insurance to conduct workshops and interactive events. Artist/curators must have or be willing to obtain adequate personal and public liability insurance of \$20 million to facilitate a public workshop.
- Successful artist/s will hold appropriate clearance if working with minors.
- Successful artist/s are required to be rostered onsite one Saturday each month during the exhibition.

## Curator

- Successful curator will have adequate public and personal liability insurance.
- Successful curator will ensure associated artists hold adequate public and personal liability insurance if holding interactive events associated with exhibition.
- Successful curator and/or associated artists are required to gallery sit for two Saturdays during the exhibition.
- Successful curator will hold or ensure associated artists hold appropriate DHS clearance if working with minors.
- Sauerbier House will provide curator with artist agreements.

## Selection

- Successful applicants are selected by the Sauerbier House Reference Group.
- Applicants will be selected on the following considerations:
  - on merit - conceptual rigour and originality of exhibition proposal
  - engagement - facilitate creative opportunities for wider community
  - viability - suitability to Sauerbier House facilities
  - originality - work has not previously exhibited in South Australia
- The Reference Group's decision is final, and no further correspondence will be entered. Should an applicant be unsuccessful, feedback from the selection process can be made available on request.

## Eligibility

- Applicant must be professional and practicing contemporary artists/curator
- The applicant may be at any stage of their career
- The applicant may reside within or outside of the City of Onkaparinga.
- The applicant may apply individually or collaboratively as a partnership or group.
- The applicant may work in any medium or discipline. Some disciplines will be more suitable to Sauerbier House facilities.
- The applicant/s must be 18 years at least two months prior to commencing residence

Applications close **midnight Monday 26 September 2022**

Applications should be completed online unless otherwise negotiated.
