## Frequently Asked Questions

### Who needs to give permission?

South Australian Power Network and City of Onkaparinga need to give permission before painting begins.

### How do I contact SAPN?

Email [stobiepoleart@groups.sapowernetworks.com.au](mailto:stobiepoleart@groups.sapowernetworks.com.au) or call 13 12 61 during business hours.

### What is the maximum height?

Area painted must be less than 2 metres from ground level.

### Do I need to tell the neighbours?

Yes. Let adjoining neighbours know what is proposed and seek their agreement, completing their details over the page.

### What about safety when painting?

You are responsible for your safety. When working, we recommend you wear a high visibility vest and use orange cones in the area. Stay off the road and do not block the footpath. You can also paint your design on blue board at home and then attach the board to the pole using a suitable construction glue. The board must

not be wider than the pole and still be less than 2 metres from the ground.

### What kind of paint should be used?

Quality exterior grade paint which is used in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines. Consider using an anti-graffiti coating when finished

### Who is responsible for maintaining the artwork?

You are responsible for looking after the artwork. If the work is damaged, SA Power Network will paint over the work.

### What support is on offer?

A dedicated Community Connections Officer will act as your main contact within council and support you every step of the way.

### What type of art can be put up?

Examples of artwork located on Stobie Poles in City of Onkaparinga can be found below as a guide. A Community Connections Officer can support you if required.
