

Local government election signage 2022

Permitted

Candidate election advertising, including corflute signs, may be placed on private land with the landowner's consent.

Advertising must be of a political nature and must not:

- be more than 2m²
- move
- flash
- be internally illuminated
- reflect light (so it doesn't distract motorists).

Candidates may choose to undertake alternative methods for advertising such as door knocking, phone contact, flyers/letter box drops or social media.

Not permitted

Candidate election advertising, including corflute and plastic signs, is not permitted on council or public land (including road verges). This is a change from previous local government elections and is the same rule across all councils.

Please note that some council's may be allowing other types of signs (paper or cardboard for example) on verges and reserves – this is not the case in Onkaparinga.

Council will be monitoring the area prior to, during and after the election to ensure compliance with election signage.

Removal of unauthorised signage and expiations may be issued for non-compliance.
