



The bookstore on the beach - Brenda Novak


Legacy - Nora Roberts




The final twist - Jeffery Deaver


Vanished - James Delargy


The Dream Weavers - Barbara Erskine


Worst idea ever- Jane Fallon


Bila Yarrudhanggalangdhuray (River of dreams) - Anita Heiss
