12.1 Notice of Rescission Motion (Cr Y Wenham)

Cr Greaves MOVED:

1. *That:*

- a. *under the provisions of Section 90(2) of the Local Government Act 1999 an order be made that the public be excluded from attendance at the meeting in order to consider in confidence this item.*
- b. *the Council is satisfied that it is necessary that the public be excluded to enable the Council to consider the information at the meeting on the following grounds:*
