

11.3 McLaren Vale and Fleurieu Visitors Centre Update

Cr Arbon declared a conflict of interest due to his partner's position on the board of the MVGWTA and left his seat in the chamber at 8.24pm.

Cr Fletcher MOVED

That

- a. *under the provisions of Section 90(2) of the Local Government Act 1999 an order be made that the public be excluded from attendance at the meeting with the exception of Chief Executive Officer, Group Manager Governance, General Manager City Development, General Manager Corporate Services, Acting General Manager City Services, Economic Development Officer, and the Minute Secretary in order to consider in confidence this item.*
- b. *the Council is satisfied that it is necessary that the public be excluded to enable the Council to consider the report at the meeting on the following grounds:*
 - (b) *information the disclosure of which -*
 - (i) *could reasonably be expected to confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the council is conducting, or proposing to conduct, business, or to prejudice the commercial position of the council; and*
 - (ii) *would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest;*
 - (d) *commercial information of a confidential nature (not being a trade secret) the disclosure of which -*
 - (i) *could reasonably be expected to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied the information, or to confer a commercial advantage on a third party; and*
 - (ii) *would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest;*
- c. *That accordingly, on this basis the principle that meetings of the Council should be conducted in a place open to the public has been outweighed by the need to keep the information or discussion confidential.*

That Council receive and note the progress in the Task Force's investigations into scenarios for the future of the McLaren Vale & Fleurieu Visitors Centre.

That an order be made under the provisions of Section 91(7) and (9) of the Local Government Act 1999 that the abovementioned document (or part of such document) including the minutes and the report of the Council relating to discussion of the subject matter of that document, having been dealt with on a confidential basis under Section 90 of the Act, should be kept confidential on the grounds of information contained in 90(3)(b), 90(3)(d) until the future of the McLaren Vale and Fleurieu Visitors Centre is resolved to the satisfaction of Council and the McLaren Vale Grape Wine and Tourism Association.
