15.1 Confidential Report – Update on Aldinga Airfield

Personal Explanation (Cr Nash)

I have considered it best to remove myself from matters relating to Aldinga Aviation in recent months to avoid any perception of bias on my behalf in fulfilling my role as a member of the DAP. However, this was in the context of their being active matters for consideration before the DAP. There are no such active matters at present and hence I do not believe it necessary to remove myself from consideration of this report before the Council.

- a. Under the provisions of Section 90(2) of the Local Government Act 1999 an order be made that the public be excluded from attendance at the meeting in order to consider in confidence this item.*

- c. Accordingly, on this basis the principle that meetings of the Council should be conducted in a place open to the public has been outweighed by the need to keep the information or discussion confidential.*

That the matter of the Confidential Report - Aldinga Airfield having been considered in confidence under Section 90(3)(h) of the Local Government Act 1999 an order be made under the provisions of Section 91(7) and (9) of the Local Government Act 1999 that the Confidential Report - Aldinga Airfield and the attachment, minutes and the relating discussion of the subject matter be kept confidential for a period of two months after Council determines the validity of Development Application 7150/1977 and its conditions.*
